## SECRETARY

This last year has been a great one for both myself as secretary, and for the club. We have really built on the solid foundation we set in 2004-05. In 2005-06, we have improved our information network with not only the "The Girraween Athlete" distributed once a month but also "Girraween This Week", which is a once a week e-mail letting our members know what is on each week. Combined with information and Club Circulars sent from Athletics NSW and other related organisations, Girraween Athletics Club members are the most well informed of any athletics club in NSW.

Our club continues to get bigger, better and more innovative both on and off the track. Both athletes from other clubs and officials look on at us with respect. We compete hard but fairly and always shake hands at the end of our races. Our blue and white colours stand out in the crowd and are now more recognisable than any other. Not only in ANSW events but, in fun runs and other community events throughout NSW and beyond. We again had a good winter season but came on in leaps and bounds during the summer.

The highlights of 2005/06 for me have included: -

(1) We had 100 members for the second year in succession with Penny Vandenberg being our 100<sup>th</sup> member this year. We ended the season with 104 members. (2) We again had a large number of teams in the State Relays and even though we only earned 1 medal all of our members tried hard and quite a few did personal bests. (3) We again finished in the top 20 in the Club Premiership. This included a fantastic 6<sup>th</sup> placing in the men's O/35 competition. (We would have finished higher but a Steeplechase race at Bankstown was cancelled due to faulty equipment with 6 of our athletes ready to run). (4) We achieved our highest ever position in the State Club Championships with both our men's and women's teams finishing 10<sup>th</sup>. (5) We earned 31 medals in State Championships events over all age groups including, an unprecedented 8 state champions. (6) We had two representatives at the recent National Masters Track & Field Championships and earned a total of 8 medals. (7) Our Steeplechase programme has really taken off in the past year. We earned a total of 7 state medals in Steeplechase alone. Having our own training steeple has helped attract interest. (8) We again had good numbers at ANSW All-Comers meets. (9) Our members have represented the club far and wide once again at Dubbo, Mingara, Canberra, Newcastle, Wollongong, Adelaide, New Zealand and in the USA.

In conclusion, 2005/06 has been another successful season and we will only get stronger with the experience we have gained. It has been great to be a part of it as secretary over the last two years. Hopefully my successor will have as much enjoyment in the position as I have.

Also an additional profit to a sum of \$202.00 was raised from the Winter Photo C. D. sales.

Finally I would like to thank for all the helpers throughout the season in assisting the canteen and sausage sizzles, which resulted in a rewarding contribution to our club.

## **COACHING**

We have had healthy numbers at training on Mondays and Wednesdays at C.V. Kelly over the last year, with an average of 11 athletes per session. In fact, on one occasion, we had an attendance of 23. It was encouraging for me to see the enthusiasm of the athletes who have attended and the improvement they have shown. It was great to see a number of our regulars progress to a higher level and compete at ANSW All-Comers, Club Premiership, State Relays, State Club Championships, SMC and U/16, U/18, U/20, Open and Masters State Championships. They all did very well to not only earn medals but personal bests as well.

However, the coaching success story continues to be our Tuesday night steeplechase sessions at Homebush. All of the athletes who have attended have improved their speed, endurance, dry hurdle and water jump technique. In fact, our club has done so well at the event that we are now regarded by both athletes and officials as "The Steeplechase capital of Sydney". Our athletes earned the following medals: - Jamie Sherson – 1<sup>st</sup> U/17 State All-Schools, 2<sup>nd</sup> U/17 Combined High Schools, 2<sup>nd</sup> State U/18's, 1<sup>st</sup> State U/20's and 2<sup>nd</sup> National U/18 Test Match (Jamie also placed 4<sup>th</sup> at the U/17 National All-Schools), Brad Milosevic – 3<sup>rd</sup> State U/18's and 2<sup>nd</sup> State U/20's, Reece Diaz – 1<sup>st</sup> State U/16's, Andrew Blunden – 2<sup>nd</sup> State U/16's and Stacey Argent – 2<sup>nd</sup> State U/20's. Nick Hanna and Adam Sinclair have improved as the season progressed and will be even better in the future. Lisa Grant also attended during the year in preparation for the Uni Games and again did well at this event. With the lack of specialised training on offer in this event, our Tuesday sessions have even attracted athletes from other clubs and these athletes also earned medals at both State and National level.



Another great innovation has been the purchase of our very own training Steeple at C.V. Kelly thanks to George Milosevic and his company, SMC. This has allowed us to have more Steeple training sessions after our normal training on Mondays and Wednesdays and allowed us to be more flexible for those that cannot attend on Tuesdays. This will certainly be a great asset to us in the future and will perhaps help us to attract new athletes to the club who are interested in the event.

While we now have a degree of flexibility in what we can offer with coaching, it would be great if other members could follow the lead and sit for their coaching certificate as well. That way, we can offer more training options in the near future and reach even more of our members each week. This past year has been thoroughly enjoyable for me personally as Coaching Co-ordinator. As a result, I have high hopes that the successful foundation that we have built since July 2004 will continue to be built upon during 2006-07.

## SUMMER COMPETITION

Girraween Athletics Club has once again enjoyed a highly successful Summer Competition. The 2005 / 2006 season enjoyed a large number of members competing at CV Kelly Park. In total, 152 athletes took part in the Summer Competition.

A comprehensive point scoring competition was used to determine the 2005 / 2006 Summer Competition Champion and place getters. The system is based on an athlete scoring points by competing (1 point), equalling a personal best (1.5 points) or achieving a personal best (2 points). The four best events each week are counted for each competitor and the points accumulated over the season. At the end of the season, the four lowest scoring weeks are subtracted from the total. This system, which has been used for many years, is fair in that it allows for enthusiastic competition in the track and field.

The categories are **Under 20**, **Senior** (20 to 39 years for men, 20 to 34 years for women) and **Masters** (40 years + for men and 35 years + for women). 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places are available within each category, catering for men and women. From these placings, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> awards have been presented to the top three men and women. The highest award, Club Champion, is presented to the male or female who has scored the highest total of points for the season.

As with previous seasons, this year's competition was decided during the last weeks of the season. Congratulations to **Stephen Blunden** who is our 2005/2006 season's **Club Champion**. Steve is one of our newer members and displayed a great deal of potential even in his early visits to CV Kelly Park. Steve attended on a very regular basis and he gained at least three PB's on eight occasions throughout the season. Congratulations and well done, **Steve**.

The women's competition was won well by **Kelly Micallef**. Kelly's closest rival is indeed a rival, her sister **Brenda Micallef** who was only two points behind. Kelly scored 67 points and Brenda scored 65 points. Another one of our new faces, **Katrina Russell**, was placed 3<sup>rd</sup> on 56 points.

Another indication of this year's close competition was displayed in the men's competition. In recent years, members in the Masters age group have been close contenders for the Championship title. Congratulations to Stephen Blunden for winning the men's competition this year with 88 points. **Wayne Thurlow** displayed his new found strength after training for his first marathon and was placed 2<sup>nd</sup>, gaining 83 points. The Blunden family almost had a quinella with Andrew Blunden gaining 3<sup>rd</sup> place on 78 points, only 10 points behind his Dad.
