It was great to see Taylor Doyle and Lynette Smith make a return to the track after a lengthy absence and they both competed very well. Todd Owen, Ryan Owen, Nicholas Hanna and Rob Giesler were other stalwarts who flew the Girraween flag well throughout December and are to be complimented on their efforts in many challenging events. One of our youngest athletes, Rowena Milliss, also made an appearance in the last meet of the year and ran a great time in her 800m at Homebush in very warm conditions. This young lady has enormous potential, there is no doubt about that. All our athletes who competed in these ANSW events are to be congratulated for representing Girraween so well. It is to be hoped in 2013 that more of our athletes avail themselves of the opportunity to join them in these ANSW events, as it is important as a club that we have a presence at these meets.

One of the highlights of this or any other month was the appearance of Brad Milosevic in the Zatopek 10 held in Melbourne in early December. This event, doubling as the Australian 10,000m championships is one of the highlights of the Australian athletics calendar. So for Brad to not only compete in this event but to run well was one of the highlights of his career to-date and as we have seen elsewhere Brad was kind enough to share his experiences of competing with the elite of Australian distance running. It was a historic moment for Girraween Athletics Club, as it is believed that Brad was the first of our members to run in the Zatopek 10. You won't see her name in the 5km results, as she didn't finish the race.
